Fishing licences should be obtained before flying out to camp. You can obtain your Ontario Outdoors Card and Fishing Licence Tag online at <https://www2.on.wildlifelicense.com/start.php> or from T.J.'s Kwik Stop (ESSO Station) or Red Lake Marine.

If you already have an Ontario Outdoors Card you should have it with you.

Fishing Tackle:

Besides your favorite lures, you should bring 3/8 jigs and twisters for Walleye. Spinner and crank baits for Northern. You should also enclose fishing rods in suitable cases to avoid damaging them when flying to camp. Please keep in mind the length of your rod cases and coolers. Coolers should not be longer than 3 feet. Avoid packing containers that takes two people to lift. Since these items will be handled several times, lightweight, sturdy containers will make loading and unloading easier.

Canada Customs will allow you to bring into Canada: one 1.14 ltr. of hard spirits or 24 (12 fl. Oz.) cans or bottles of beer and one carton of cigarettes per person.
